Policy on Academic Honesty

The school promotes a set of values and skills that are based on personal integrity and originality.

- All course work, research or project based assignments will refer sources and mark words not one's own clearly in quotes and italics.
- There must be no extensive use of quotes or close paraphrasing. Instead, a good use of other people's ideas would be simply to pick out key words and analyze the same in various contexts and arrive at one's own conclusion.
- Usage of a photo copy of a text book is considered an infringement of copyright thereby making it unlawful.
- Cheating or malpractice in the form of taking unauthorized material into the examination room constitutes a serious violation of Academic Honesty.
- Any form of collusion, plagiarism or duplication of work by either teacher or student will constitute infringement of intellectual property.
- The school reserves the right to respond to cases of academic dishonesty and the action taken by the examining board will be upheld by the school.
- Recourse to getting internal assessments or course work written by external agents constitutes a serious violation of academic honesty. A high standard of ethical behaviour is expected inside and outside the school and the school absolves itself of any involvement of such irresponsible acts.
