## 3. No Photocopying of Textbooks:

• Usage of photocopies of textbooks is considered an infringement of copyright and is unlawful.

## 4. Cheating and Malpractice:

• Cheating or any form of malpractice during examinations, including the use of unauthorized materials, is a serious violation of Academic Honesty.

### 5. Collusion and Plagiarism:

• Any form of collusion, plagiarism, or duplication of work, whether by teachers or students, constitutes a breach of intellectual property.
