Dear Parents,

We are happy to note that we have completed the First Term successfully with the participation and full support of our parents. We would sincerely like to thank each one of you for your cooperation as always.

Punctuality and Discipline are two habits whose importance must always be highlighted. Childhood is the right phase to work on and pick up these lifelong habits. In this connection, we would like to share a few observations regarding the punctuality of some of our students.

Despite our best efforts to instill the practice of punctuality, we find there are still some students who are frequent late comers to school beyond the specified time.

Henceforth the following measures will be in place for late comers:

Middle and High schoolers: will lose 3 points from their House score and 2 points from their Report Cards reducing their weightage.

Uniform turnout and hairstyles as mentioned in the school diary must also be followed. Frequent disregard could attract similar measures as for the latecomers.

The school's teaching and learning medium of instruction is strictly English only. As part of improving the language proficiency and conversation skills of our students, the school would like to emphasize that students converse in English only.
