Dear Parents and Students,

As the CBSE Board Examinations 2026 approach, your cooperation is essential to ensure a smooth, fair, and stress-free examination process. Kindly note the following instructions:

- Students must report to the examination centre by **8:15 AM sharp**, and no entry will be permitted after this time. Latecomers will be marked **ABSENT**, as no provision for re-examination is allowed.
- The examination centre is **The Millennium School, Al Baghdad Street, Behind Lulu hypermarket, Al Qusais**.
- Students must report to the home school by **7:30 AM**, and buses to the examination centre will depart strictly at **7:40 AM**.
- The students will be brought back to the school after the examination and the bus users can use the school transport in the afternoon.
- Students are not permitted to leave the examination hall before the conclusion of the exam and must maintain complete discipline throughout. Any misconduct, damage to property, or littering will invite strict action. The decision of the **Centre Superintendent** will be final.
- Students must carry only essential stationery such as geometrical instruments, blue/royal blue pens, scale, and eraser in a **transparent pouch**.
- Strictly prohibited items include any textual material, bits of paper, calculators, electronic devices, communication gadgets, wallets, handbags, and eatables (except for diabetic students). Possession of such items will be treated as use of **unfair means** and will attract strict penalties.
- The **Admit Card** must be carried on all examination days and produced for verification when required. Students must be in complete school uniform (Monday–Wednesday uniform) along with the School Identity Card.
- All entries on the answer sheet must be neat and accurate. Students must write their **Roll Number carefully in both words and figures**, and avoid any overwriting on the OMR sheet, as it may not be recognized by the system.
- Students are advised not to believe or circulate any rumours or fake messages regarding question paper leaks. Strict action will be taken against those involved in spreading misinformation, and only official communication from the Board should be considered valid.
- Students may be required to witness the opening of the question paper packet and sign the certificate to confirm it is intact.
- Any discrepancy or ambiguity in the question paper must be reported to the school immediately.
- Parents and students must verify the details on the Admit Card and sign the undertaking provided.
